EVENT OVERVIEW

The Trust Services & eID Forum (TSF) and the CA Day will take place on 24 and 25 September 2025 at the FESB Faculty of the University of Split, Croatia. As in previous years (since 2018), both events are co-organized by ENISA and European Commission, D-Trust and TÜV Nord Cert.

- **24 September:** Trust Services & eID Forum (09:30–17:00 CEST)
- **25 September:** CA Day (09:00–17:00 CEST)
- **Venue:** FESB - Faculty of Electrical Engineering, Mechanical Engineering and Naval Architecture, University of Split, Ruđera Boškovića 32, Split, Croatia
- Registration desks will open at 08:30 on both days in the FESB main lobby. Please pick up your badge before entering the auditorium.

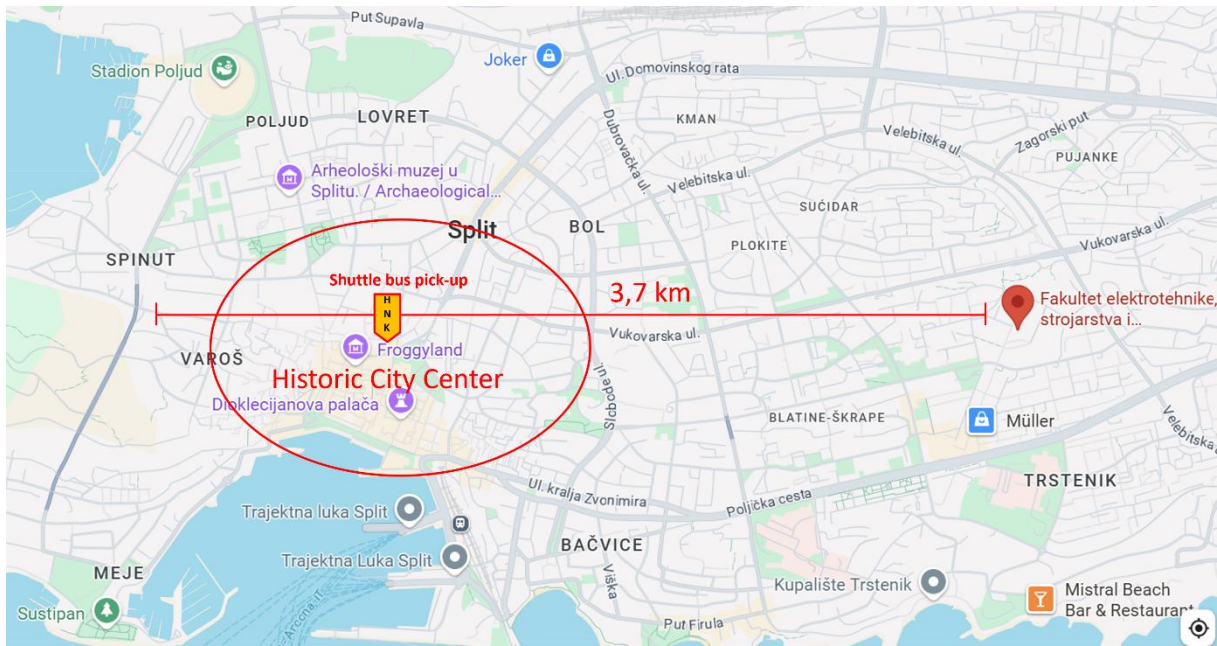
LOCATION

Split, the second-largest city in Croatia, is located on the Dalmatian coast and renowned for its historical charm—most notably the Diocletian's Palace, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. The city centre is quite small so that many places can be reached by foot or a short drive by car or bus. The airport can be reached within a 30–40 minutes drive from the city centre.

For accommodation we highly recommend to check private apartments and rooms in the city centre (see on the map below) that are offered on various popular online booking engines. They offer more affordable rates and a wider range of options.

Here are some hotels that are close to the venue:

SHUTTLE BUSES

Free shuttle buses will be available for participants on both event days. Please note that the capacity might be limited (first come, first served).

Morning Departure from HNK Bus station (Trg Gaje Bulata) to FESB:

- Wednesday, 24th: 8:30 am and 8:50 am
- Thursday, 25th: 8:00 am and 8:20 am

Return Departure from FESB to HNK Bus station (Trg Gaje Bulata):

- Wednesday, 24th: 18:00 pm and 19:00 pm
- Thursday, 25th: 17:15 pm and 17:35 pm

ALTERNATIVE PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION

You can also reach FESB using Split's public bus system:

- **Line 18 to Matice Hrvatske – Kampus 1**
- **Line 6 to Vukovarska – Kampus**

Tickets can be purchased directly from the driver or in advance at kiosks (e.g. *Tisak*).

All major ride-hailing services are available in Split (e.g. Bolt, Uber, Taxis), as well as regular city taxis. Rides from the city centre to FESB typically take about 10-20 minutes, depending on the traffic, and cost around 30 EUR.

SOCIAL EVENTS

On the 24th of September, after the Trust Services & eID Forum, we invite all participants to a casual Get-Together with drinks and snacks at the venue (FESB). This informal networking session will last approximately 2 hours.

Afterwards, participants are welcome to explore Split on their own—whether it's enjoying the vibrant historic city centre, taking a relaxing walk through Marjan Park, or even going for a late-night swim at one of the city beaches (Znjan, Bacvice).

WEATHER

The weather in Split at the end of September is still very mild, Mediterranean. You can expect temperatures around 25 degrees during the day, dropping to 15-20 by night. Rains in this period are rare, but can occasionally happen.

FUN FACTS

- There is a beach at the airport (10 min walk) “Beach Divulje” – it might be a nice way to spend time if you are early at the airport or there is a delay
- You Can Drink the Tap Water – Split’s drinking water comes from the Jadro River and is known for its freshness and purity.
- Outside the Golden Gate of the palace stands the statue of Grgur Ninski (Gregory of Nin). Locals and tourists alike rub his big toe for good luck—so much that it shines golden.
