— on the legal/regulatory and procedural challenges and the incentives for the information-sharing and the cooperation of CERTs from Europe with CERTs and LEAs of third countries;

(b) lot 2: development and deployment of EISAS — pilot project. ENISA procured services for launching and coordinating a pilot of EISAS basic toolset deployment in 1 European Union Member State (EU MS) with support and cooperation of another EU MS;

(c) lot 3: CERT inventory update & upgrade. The contractor will need to build upon the existing CERT inventory (Web version & downloadable documents) and develop a comprehensive, newly designed CERT inventory document along with an interactive map of CERT teams in Europe with the emphasis on the national and governmental CERTs.
